## COUNTRY MEADOW ESTATES HOA, INC. Considerate Parking Guidelines

- When parking in a driveway, be sure your vehicle does not extend over the sidewalk.
- Park facing the direction you would be driving on that side of the road. This will facilitate taillight visibility in the evenings.
- When snow is expected, avoid parking in the street to allow for efficient snow plow service.
- Limit trailer and/or motorhome parking on the street to 72 hours before or after a planned trip.
- Park on only one side of the street in any one location (avoid multiple parking lanes on same street area).
- All vehicles parked on the street should be in good condition (ie., not leaking oil which could damage the road surface).
- Vehicles parked on street should be at least 6 feet from edge of driveway and/or mailbox area.
- Avoid parking vehicles on street directly across from driveways.
- When parking a trailer, motorhome or boat on homeowner's lot or in their driveway for an extended period of time, it is preferred that the front of the vehicle (closest to the road) extends no closer to the street than the front of the house.
- When storing vehicles within property lines, please be considerate of sightlines from all shared neighbors.
